2 **Progress this Quarter**

2.1 Planning Approvals and CEMP Status:

- All plans have been updated to accommodate changes from Staging Report (Rev 6.03).
- CEMP was sent to DPIE for approval on 28th August 2020. Comments from DPIE were received on 23rd September 2020, SOM are preparing responses.
- Sub Plan consultation has commenced with relevant government agencies.
- Project briefing held with NSW Health on 16th July 2020 on SOM scope and the Noise and Vibration Management and Monitoring plan.
- Consultation Reports for the CFMP, CHMP and CSWMP have been submitted to the ER for endorsement.
- ONVR Memos relating to brownfield and greenfield noise have been prepared and sent to EPA for consideration on 17th September 2020. Consultation with EPA is scheduled for early October.
- Consultation with Heritage Office ongoing regarding design at Dundas and Carlingford stops, and implications for implementation of interpretive material.

- GRCLR-PCMWA-004 (Geotechnical) Approved by TfNSW 2nd September 2020.
- GRCLR-PCMWA 005 (CCTV and Survey) endorsed by ER 18th June 2020 and approved by TfNSW on 25th June 2020. Environmental Review endorsed by ER 30th June 2020 for works under flexibility provisions in planning condition A12.
- GRCLR-PCMWA 006 (Non-Intrusive) Approved by TfNSW 29th September 2020.

- Height of the Administration and Maintenance building at SaMF.
- Use of the SaMF site as a Construction Compound.

2.2 Environmental Training:

• Training needs are being determined and packages developed for commencement of construction.

2.3 Interface Matters:

- Interface meetings with PCPLR occurred on 7th July 2020 and 16th September. The next meeting with PCPLR is scheduled for 10th November 2020.
- Ongoing weekly SOM/Remediation Contractor interface meetings and workshops are occurring.
