2 Progress this Quarter

This Quarterly Environment Report covers 2021 Quarter 1 (Q1 - from 01/01/2021 to 31/03/2021).

2.1 Planning Approvals and Management Plan Status

The management plans have been split into two groups for the Supply, Operate and Maintain (SOM – Package 5) works, covering the Stabling and Maintenance Facility (SaMF – Activity A) and Whole Alignment (Activity B), where appropriate.

For Activity A, the Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) and all sub-plans have been approved by Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) or endorsed by the Environmental Representative (ER),Acoustic Advisor (AA), as required by the Project Approval (Application No. SSI 8285). The CEMP was approved by DPIE on 09/03/2021. At the end of the reporting period, the Site Establishment Management Plan (SEMP) for the SaMF site had been reviewed by TfNSW and was with the ER for review/endorsement.

At the end of the reporting period, the status of the Activity B plans yet to be approved/endorsed was:

- CEMP With DPIE for review/approval
- Flora and Fauna Management Plan With the ER for review/endorsement
- Transport, Traffic and Access Management Plan Being prepared by Great River City Light Rail (GRCLR)
- SEMP Being prepared by GRCLR.

All other Activity B CEMP sub-plans have been approved/endorsed as required by the Project Approval.

2.1.1 Pre-Construction Minor Works Approval Status

- CCTV inspection completed by GRCLR on 31/03/2021.

2.1.2 Consistency Assessments Status

2.2 Environmental Audits and Training

Project Audit Schedule developed to ensure project audit requirements are met. No audits were conducted during the reporting peiord.

Various training packages in development and training/toolbox meeting schedule drafted for implementation at the commencement of construction.

2.3 Interface Matters

Interface meetings with PCPLR were held on 11/02/2021and 11/03/2021.

Weekly GRCLR/Remediation Contractor interface meetings and workshops are ongoing.

2.4 Conditions of Approval

Reports and notifications to DPIE required under Schedule 1 of the Project Approval are listed below in Appendix 1, which includes a SOM – Package 5 status update reflecting progress against each reporting requirement.

Detailed compliance reporting addressing GRCLR progress against the requirements of the Conditions of Approval (CoAs), Environment Performance Objectives (EPOs) and Revised Environmental Mitigation Measures (REMMs) is undertaken quarterly in INX.

Of note, a meeting was held with DPIE and TfNSW on 24/02/2021 regarding progress on preparation of the Operational Noise and Vibration Report (ONVR), with regular meetings planned in the future.

2.5 Environmental Design Requirements

The GRCLR Environment, Planning and Sustainability (EPS) team has been working closely with the Design team to review design packages and ensure compliance with the CoA, EPOs and REMMs relevant to design.

Environmental Design Review Reports (EDRRs) are being prepared with each design package submitted for Detailed Design Review (DDR).

EDRR activities for the reporting period are summarised in Table 1.

The CEMP is not an active document until commencement of construction works. Compliance reporting against the CEMP will commence in the first reporting period after the commencement of construction.

There were no environmental non-compliances for Q1 2021. The design has progressed with input from the EPS team. Pre-Construction Minor Works Approvals have progressed, but no construction works have commenced.
